JESSI'S COMICS

Jessi Eoin comes to comics from an illustration background, so their comics work is a constant endeavor to develop a style better suited for working in sequential art while finding ways to incorporate the botanical themes and lively colors their work has become known for.

Their most recently published comics have been autobio focused, exploring themes of a deeply personal nature to them. A Long Eviction is a micro comic exploring coping with anxiety and past traumas, while the (tiny) friend examines Jessi's endeavors to build and rely more on community via a tired, tiny old fairy.

Their current work is shifting to embrace even more robustly fantasy themes in their comics; at the moment, they're working on two mini disabled horror fantasy comics.

Burden is a disabled horror fantasy story about a lamb being born to humans and how those humans react to its presence.

Don't Feed the Faeries, Darling is a disabled horror fantasy delving into fae folklore and how an isolated, disabled child comes to interact with them.

They also have a currently untitled long form comic they're working on centering around an ancient, exiled witch who, in the course of her care-taking duties, comes across three frolicsome children from an isolated human village suffering from catastrophic climate changes linked to fae activities in the Immortal Realm.



Jessi's illustrative works continue to focus on creating positive representations of disabled, fat, queer, and trans characters, incorporating botanical elements and fantasy themes more and more.

They feel this dedication to creating works with positive representation of marginalized characters is even more important now with an increase in the societal embrace of eugenics.

They're working to create more narrative pieces these days, strongly influenced by folklore about Irish, Scottish, and Welsh fae and other creatures.

Similarly, Jessi is exploring the use of more texture and color in their pieces, experimenting with various digital brushes, traditional mediums, and color palettes as they make art.
